

How to Reach the City of Užice

Visitors can come to Serbia by air, road or rail.

- 1) If you travel **by plane**, you will land at Nikola Tesla Airport in the capital city of Serbia, Belgrade, which is about 200 km far from the City of Užice. The airport is 18 km far from the centre of Belgrade. However, there are frequent bus departures from the airport to the city centre and the main bus station. You can also take a taxi at a price of around 15 euros, or hire a car. For further information about the transport from the airport to the city centre, please click here: <https://beg.aero/eng>

Once you reach Belgrade Bus Station, there are frequent departures to the City of Užice. The timetable is available at the following link:

- 2) If you decide to come to Serbia **by train**, we suggest getting to Belgrade Centre Railway Station - Prokop, from which you can continue your trip to Užice as there are frequent departures. For the timetable, please visit the following link: <http://w3.srbraail.rs/ZSRedVoznje/en>
- 3) If you travel **by car**, you can reach the City of Užice using several roads.

Note: If you wish to take a taxi from Belgrade to the City of Užice, please contact our International Office members, who will arrange a taxi ride for you with some of the taxi associations from the City of Užice, including the driver waiting for you at the airport with a sign. This service costs around 60 euros.
